The partnership of EFW Radiology is currently accepting applications for a **casual Physiotherapist for the EFW Clinical Assessment Unit**. This position will be scheduled 11 hours per week (8 hours on Wednesdays and 3 hours on Thursdays) at the EFW Radiology Seton Clinic.

Working collaboratively with the CAU Specialist Physician, the successful candidate will provide advanced physiotherapy services to spine and peripheral pain management patients. Specific duties will include obtaining patient histories and completing a physical assessment; engaging in patient conference discussions with the CAU specialist physician; collaborating in the development of a comprehensive customized treatment plan and goals for patient; as well as creating patient reports and exercise treatment programs and undertaking timely patient follow-up regard the progression of treatment.

Eligible candidates must have:

- Completed a bachelors or master's degree in a recognized university physiotherapy program. Specialized training and/or advanced certification in complex musculoskeletal disorders is an asset.
- Successfully passed the national Physiotherapy competency examination and hold an active registration and practice permit with Physiotherapy Alberta: College + Association.
- A minimum of 5 years of recent experience working with diverse patient populations and providing physiotherapy services to patients with spine, joint, nerve, or tendon conditions.
- A sincere desire to work with pain management patients and a commitment to provide an exceptional interaction to each patient.
- The ability to work independently as well as collaboratively with a dynamic, fast paced interdisciplinary team.
- Sound clinical judgment and critical thinking skills.
- Demonstrated commitment to and participation in activities which promote professional and personal growth and development.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Strong computer and dictation skills are required.
- Effective time management skills including the ability to complete tasks within established timeframes.
- The ability to spend periods of time reaching, standing, and bending while supporting and assisting patients.
